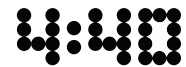

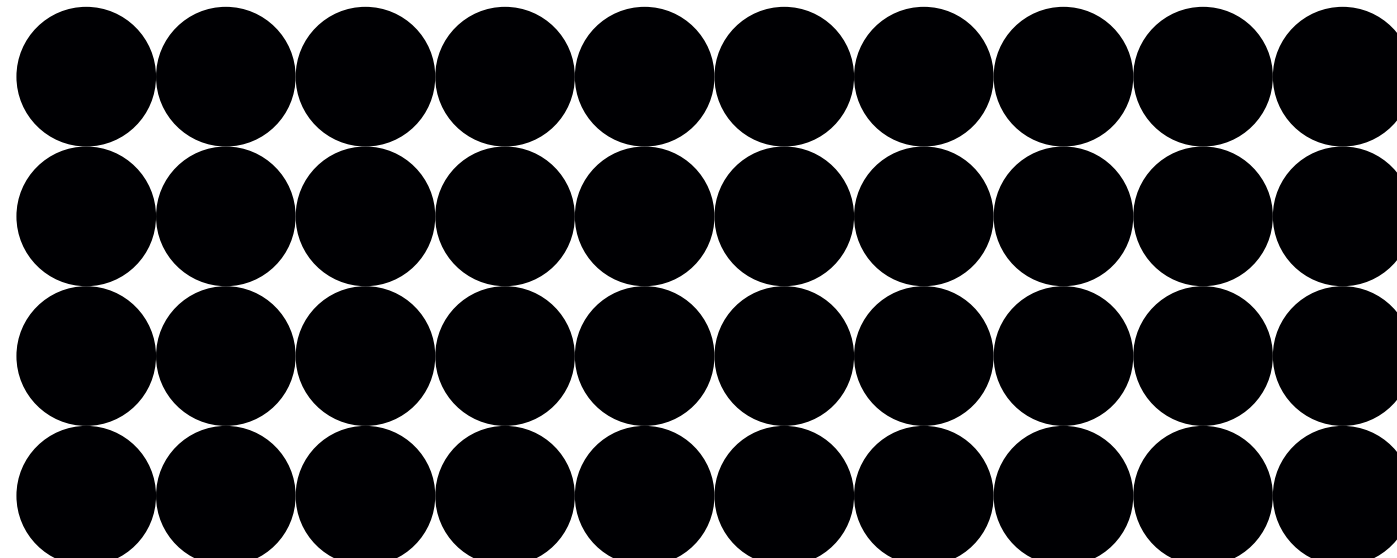
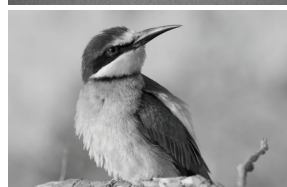

Calblanque Regional Park is a Protected Natural Area with a huge environmental, landscape and cultural value. It includes wild beaches appreciated for their excellent conservation level.

In summer, lots of visitors come to Calblanque to enjoy the beautiful beaches. In order to avoid the negative effect of motor vehicles on the wildlife and to preserve this prestigious place, Access Control is required. This measure will reduce the amount of dust that blocks the plants' ability to breathe. It also prevents wild animals from being run over and decreases the stress of visitors. Furthermore, the noise level and the fire risks will be reduced, helped by improved emergency services access.

Calblanque 4:40 arises from all of these reasons, as a public bus service to access this natural area. It will reduce the environmental impact because a 4-wheeled bus carries the same number of visitors as 10 private cars with 40 car wheels.

## This summer enjoy the Calblanque Regional Park and contribute to its preservation in 4 steps

Between 9:00 and 20:30 hours, access of motor vehicles to Calblanque is limited. Outside these hours it only will be possible get to the public parking El Atochar from 8:00 to 9:00 hours.

The access of motor vehicles to the beach area is not allowed during the night.

**1** Park your vehicle in parking areas.

**2** Buy the bus ticket.

10 trips pass**		20€

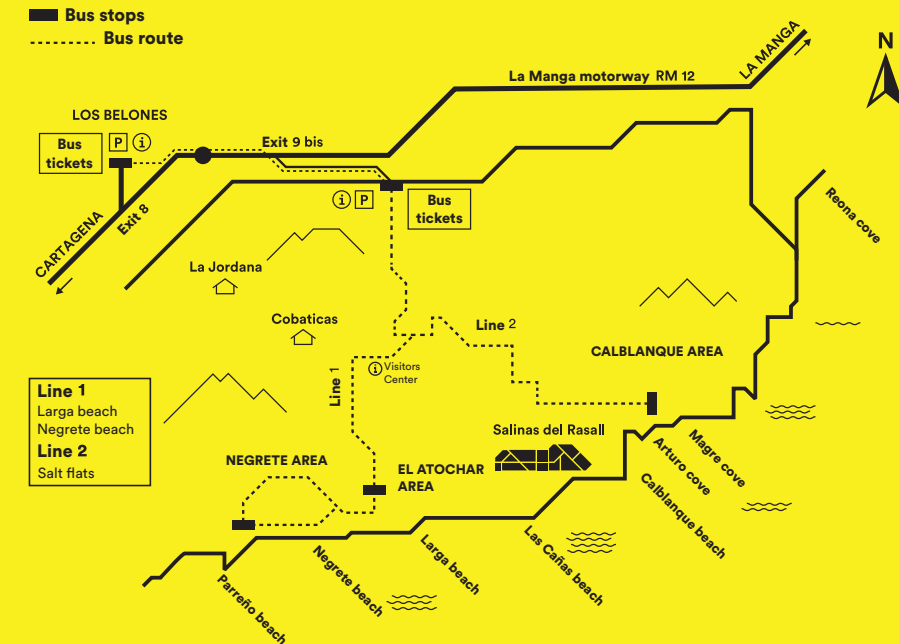
\* Large family cardholders, student cardholders, children under 12, people over 65, unemployed or people with disabilities (≥ 33%). Discounts not cumulative.

\*\* Valid for 10 round trips.

**3** Choose the bus depending on your destination beach.

Non-stop service: from 9:30 to 20:30.  
Departures every 20 minutes, approximately.

**4** Follow designated trails to reach your favourite place.
